Course description:

The course is aimed to help students to get basic knowledge about the formation, operation and development of the world economic system, especially at its current stage.

After learning the course students will know the terminology of the discipline; understand the basic and modern theories (approaches) and the problems of the world economy, and seek solutions to these problems; have possibility to analyze the stages, structure and dynamics of the modern world economic system; know the experience of individual countries, and have possibility to identify the factors of competitiveness of leading countries and global players.

Lectures and reading materials. Participating in the lectures and reading the assigned papers is essential part of the course. All enrolled students are therefore expected to participate in all lectures and read all assigned papers.

Seminars. At the seminars students learn practical cases and develop their skills to use theoretical knowledge for solving the practical cases in the field of world economy. The student performance at the seminars is assessed in accordance with three main criteria: attendance, preparedness, and activity.

Assignments:

Home tasks:

1. Home task No 1 (information search) «Internationalization of enterprises (companies, activities)».
2. Home task No 2 (presentation) «Socio-economic development of «_____» (country)».

Testing:

1. Test task No 1 (problem solving) «Global problems and challenges of the world economy».
2. Test task No 2 (calculation and graphics work) «Measuring globalization, internationalization»

Final Exam consists of an open-ended test that requires short (1-3 sentences) responses to 20 questions based on the material covered within the course and a short academic essay (2,500 words) on one of three suggested topics.
